Oenologist Konrad Hähn now continues this tradition and has achieved 2 national awards for excellence, is recommended every year by Feinschmecker Magazine and was among the Top 100 estates in 2004. The terroir is slate soil and all vines are planted on steep terraced slopes only.

Tasting note: Fine concentration of guava, pineapple, nectarine and mineral aromas and flavors. Rich and fleshy, with vibrant structure and serious body. Lingering aftertaste of fruit, spice and mineral. Drink now through 2018. 100 cases made. -BS
