Estate: The Hähn family has winemaking tradition as far back as 1648, the winery has been in Kobern since 1892. Oenologist Konrad Hähn now continues this tradition and has achieved 2 national awards for excellence, is recommended every year by Feinschmecker Magazine and was among the Top 100 estates in 2004. The terroir is slate soil and all vines are planted on steep terraced slopes only.

Tasting note: Since starting with sparkling wine in the late 1980s, the von Schleinitz Riesling Sekt has achieved gold medals in Germany every vintage. 100% estate grown Riesling, picked at high acid levels, but sufficient ripeness to provide a creamy rich texture. Very aromatic with a fine bouquet of lees due to the 12 month lees contact ageing in the cellar before degorgement.

Food affinity: Great to enjoy like Champagne – anytime.
